For those not at the Garden Hilton, the 'The Red Faculty/Staff Lot' (Administration overflow lot) will be FREE during the scientific conference (Tuesday & Wednesday).

**Oral Presentations.**

To ensure that the talks run smoothly and efficiently – we have a tight schedule – we request that all speakers send their presentations to LPW at least 24 hours in advance of their time slot. Presentations will be made in the Wang Center Theater and there will be 3 technicians available for help. If it is absolutely essential, speakers can use their own laptop, but this needs to be given to AV between sessions. Again, we highly recommend against this alternative.

Speakers, please adhere to your time slot. Long talks are 25 minutes total (20 min talk + 5 min Q/A). Short talks are 15 minutes total (12 min + 3 min Q/A). Please remember that your talk will be included in a common session, so general background slides can be minimized.

**Poster Presentations.**

Poster presentations will take place directly outside The Wang Center Theater and amid vendor tables and food service. Poster set-up can start on Tuesday morning (see below). Posters will remain up during the entire meeting.

We will not have specific times where poster presenters should be at their poster, but there will be many opportunities for Q/A during coffee and lunch breaks, so just keep an eye on your poster. Poster boards and pins will be provided.

**Wireless Internet.**

Please use **EduRoam**. It is the most convenient. There is an alternative network, 'WolfieNet guest', but this is more cumbersome.

**Welcome Reception on Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup>.**
